The Church of St. James the Less Lower Tatham

This beautiful old Church existed in some form in Saxon times & there may have been an earlier dedication to St. Wilfred in the 7th Century. Behind the altar are the remains of an ancient Saxon stone altar.

Parts of the Church are Norman with 12th century octagonal pillars and a semi-circular archway over the church door.

To the left of the altar is a carved stone coffin lid with the cross of a crusader dating from c.1100.

The church was rebuilt in the 15th Century and restored in the 1880's through the generosity of the Fosters of Hornby Castle when the tower was also raised.

At present there is no service on the third Sunday in the month.

When there is a fifth Sunday in the month a Joint Service is held at one of the six Churches in the Benefice.
