This is the Health and Safety Policy Statement of the Friends of St James the Less Church, Tatham, Charity Number 1161272

The Friends of St James the Less Church, Tatham, recognise their responsibility to ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, the health and safety of all their members and volunteers and have nominated the undersigned to control and review these matters.

Our statement of general policy is:

- To provide adequate control of the health and safety risks arising from our activities.

- To prevent accidents.
- To maintain safe and healthy working conditions.
- To have an auditable procedure and record of Health and Safety incidents.
- To review and revise this policy as necessary at regular intervals.

The implementation of the policy is the responsibility of all members and only with the co-operation of every member within it, taking care of their own safety and that of other members, can the Charity provide a safe and healthy environment.
